Summary

This position is a full-time seasonal position responsible for grooming the hill using tracked snow cats. The groomer will be able to operate all the grooming equipment in a safe and effective manner. They will aim to consistently produce a high-quality groomed snow surface that that is up to Rabbit Hill standards.

Job Duties

- Perform grooming in a reasonable and timely manner on a nightly basis, following an established plan in the following areas:
 - o All runs
 - Around buildings
 - In Terrain Parks and Tube Park
- Follow all policies and procedures for safe slope grooming including in severe weather conditions and on varied terrain
- Perform inspections of snow cat machines daily and report anything may indicate a mechanical issue.
- Maintain good communications using radios and reports as required with operators, other managers, and other departments.

- Keep machines and workspaces clean and tidy
- Ensuring quality of snow is safe and up to Rabbit Hill's standards
- Other duties as required

Requirements

- Effective communicator and problem solver
- Must work effectively with minimal supervision
- Positive and proactive approach to teamwork and working with others
- Capable of working outside in all types of weather
- Able to react quickly and remain calm under pressure
- Capable of performing physical and manual duties
- Snow cat or heavy machinery operation experience preferred
- Valid driver's license and own reliable transportation required
- Must be able to lift up to 50 lbs
- Must be over 18 years of age
- Weekend, holiday, and overnight shifts are required
- Mostly overnight shifts from 9 PM to 5 AM, Mon-Fri
- Must be able to start work around the end of October
- Preseason overtime is required and there may be regular season overtime as needed

Working Conditions

- Manual dexterity required to use heavy equipment and hand tools.
- Extended periods of sitting
- · Reaching, kneeling, bending, twisting, pulling, pushing, and lifting
- Working alone at night
- Outdoor work in extreme winter conditions.
